Things to keep in mind for the future (from 4-H staff perspective):

We were lucky in that we were able to get the school/location for free, but it was very hard to find. Most schools on the less expensive end would have charged \$150-\$250. Our county office also supplied all of the paper and printing, which other counties may not be able to do. Since this is not an annual event for our county to host, it was more difficult to budget county council funds.

The pin situation of having to estimate the correct number to order, send back what wasn't used and then bill the participating counties for a few dollars was very time consuming and challenging for a county who has not done it before. Is there an easier way to do this or can we consider having the Sectional Council pay for the pins in the future?

Securing enough volunteer judges (with experience) was a huge challenge. Please encourage parents from your counties to help in the future.

Our county-wide Fashion Revue and Quilt show was held on a Wednesday night this year. In the past we have held them on a Saturday, but encountered too many conflicts this year. The theme was "Needle In A Haystack." There were 12 entries.

Our fair clean-up day was last weekend and was well attended. All the animal pens were raked and cleaned, some flowerbeds were pruned and lots of leaves and branches were raked out of pathways, etc. There were 68 4-H and FFA Members in attendance as well as many adults.
