Camp Ocean Pines

Directions:

Camp Ocean Pines is located at 1473 Randall Drive, corner of Randall Drive and St. James Road, in Cambria, CA.

From the South: Highway 101 N to Highway 1 N in San Luis Obispo – You will pass the towns of Morro Bay, Cayucos and Harmony, pass Highway 46 and at the first stop light in Cambria you will turn left onto Ardath Dr.

Follow Ardath Dr. until it ends at Randall Dr. (There will be blue signs pointing to Camp Ocean Pines on Ardath Dr. also after the yellow sign indicating a Y in the road you will stay to the left.) Travel about 300 yards and you will see the entrance for Camp Ocean Pines on the right. There is a sign clearly marking our entrance. Take the driveway up the hill – you will stay to the right at the fork in the road (the cabins are to the left). Look for the lodge on the right, park in this area and someone from Mindfulness Retreat will greet you.

From the East: Highway 46 W to Highway 1. Turn right onto Highway 1 N toward Cambria. At the first light you will turn left onto Ardath Dr. and now follow the directions **above in bold**.

From the North: Scenic route (beautiful however potentially slow) goes along the Big Sur Coastline on Highway 1 from Monterey to Cambria. You will turn right at the 4th stop light, which is Ardath Dr. and then follow the directions **above in bold**.

Faster route is Highway 101 S to Highway 46 W to Highway 1 N toward Cambria. At the first light you will turn left onto Ardath Dr. and now follow the directions **above in bold**.

Distances from nearby public transportation terminals:

- Amtrak (San Luis Obispo) – 48 miles
- Airlines (San Luis Obispo County Airport) – 50 miles
- Greyhound Bus Lines (San Luis Obispo) – 47 miles
