

## 4-H State Field Day Entomology Contest

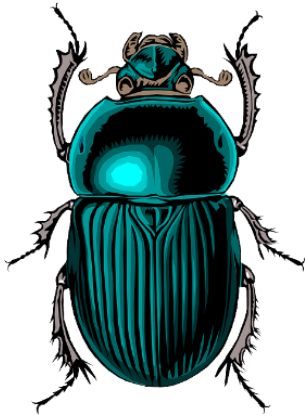
