The youth summit is a three day weekend leadership experience that is hosted in multiple locations throughout the state. The youth summits are geared for intermediate 4-H members aged 11-13, with a senior leadership option for ages 14-19. All California 4-H Youth Summit events are open for any 4-H youth member enrolled in California 4-H.

What is a participant?

A participant is a youth, age 11-13, and is an actively engaged member in the summit. Participants get the chance to meet other youth from across the state, attend educational workshops, partake in fun leadership development activities, and so much more!

What is a facilitator?

Facilitators are age 14-19. They are responsible during the Summit for leading their group of younger members and providing a good role model. But that's not all: Facilitators get to engage in fun, teen-only activities in leadership development and team bonding.
