



4-H State Field Day STEM Egg Drop

Registration: Pre-registration is not required.

Ages: All ages are welcome.

Time: 9:30 am -12 noon; Egg Drop will start at 11:30 am

Location: Balcony at Wellman Hall and table set up near Robotics contest

Awards: Participation only; no awards.

Rules:

- a) The device must fit completely inside of a gallon zip lock bag
- b) Devices that do not fit in within the prescribed space will result in automatic disqualification.
- c) The devices must freefall without contacting team members, other persons or objects.
- d) Strings, chutes, etc. may be used. Tethers, parachutes and other air resistance devices may be used and may be attached to the zip lock bag.
- e) Containers must be designed so that the egg may be inserted easily before competing, and easily checked after the drop test.
- f) The egg must stay inside the device throughout the drop test.
- g) Participants can bring supplies from home, must comply with above rules. Pre-built materials are also okay.
